Sunday mornings, January - April





SUMMER TRIP REGISTRATION

REGISTRATION OPENS NOVEMBER 1, 2024

Register early! Our trips may fill up and its best to get registered as soon as you can. When you register, a non-refundable trip deposit of \$100 will be due.

REGISTRATION

MARCH 1, 2025: REGISTRATION DEADLINE

We encourage you to register early, but March 1 is the deadline to register. Our trips have a maximum number of people we can take, and these spaces are given on a first come first serve basis, they may fill up before March 1. Each trip requires specific forms, they will be available with registration and communicated to registered participants when they are available.

REGISTRATION AFTER MARCH 1

We will do our best to register you for trips after March 1, but cannot guarantee your space. To confirm space availability, all of your paperwork and deposit must be completed and turned in. Also, the total cost of your trip could increase by 10% or more depending on the policy of the organization we are traveling with. We may only be able to accept registrations after March 1 if there is a cancellation by another registered participant.

TRIP CANCELLATIONS

Your deposit per trip per person is non-refundable. We will do our best to refund you the remainder of the balance. Refunds are based on several factors, including the amount we have already paid for registrations, the policies of the organization we go with, and the time remaining before we leave for the trip. If there is someone to take your place, we will refund you the entire cost of the trip once that person registers in full, including any additional late registration fees.

TRIP SCHOLARSHIPS

Please do not let the cost of a trip prohibit you from coming. We are blessed to have a fund specifically dedicated to help provide scholarships for youth retreats and trips. If you'd like some help with trip costs please contact John Daniel.

Volunteer Opportunities

Volunteering for our youth group on Sunday nights is a joyous opportunity to tap into your inner child, have fun, and contribute to the creation of a network of supportive and faithful adults for our youth. By walking alongside them on their journey of faith, you play a vital role in providing a safe and nurturing environment where our youth can grow, thrive, and build strong connections that will positively impact their lives for years to come.

Confirmation Group Leaders

We are always looking for individuals who are interested in serving as either Confirmation group leaders or mentors to our individual confirmands. Group leaders help facilitate discussion in small group during our confirmation sessions. If possible, we ask that group leaders make sure to be at the retreats and confirmation classes.

Mentors are personally asked and selected by the confirmands. A Confirmation mentor carries the responsibility of walking alongside a confirmand through this season of life. Our hope is that the mentor/mentee relationship develops into one well beyond the 3 months of the confirmation process!

Chaperones for Trips

Volunteering to be a chaperone on our youth group trips is a rewarding experience that allows you to forge meaningful connections with the youth on a deeper level. As a chaperone, you have the opportunity to support, guide, and mentor young individuals, creating lasting memories and positively impacting their lives through your presence and involvement.

Support List

Being a supporter of our youth ministry by joining the support list is a powerful way to uplift and encourage our youth group members. By writing cards and sending thoughtful notes, you have the opportunity to demonstrate that they are not alone, that they are loved, and that there are people praying for them, fostering a sense of belonging, support, and reassurance in their faith journey. Your small acts of kindness can have a significant impact on the lives of our youth, reminding them of the caring community that surrounds them.
